On the hundredth day I had collected all kinds of things, fruit loops, stickers, jewels, lentils, punched out bears and for sure punched out hands. The students went around to all the different tables picking out 10 of each thing and gluing it into their 100 book. The hand page was fun, we figured that one out together first, I asked the students to put 10 FINGERS on the hand page, not 10 hands.

We practiced reading the number words with our books and the books went home in their bag of back-and-forth mini books to be reviewed at home and to pull out and read when their learning buddies (grades 2 or 3 ) came to class.
